The town only has a population of about 2,500 but over 25% are refugees or immigrants because of a Lutheran Services refugee resettlement program and a local turkey plant that gets tax write offs for employing migrants.
- Individually recruited and got 17 self-isolating, distinct communities to the table to work together consistently.
- Reinstated the local Economic Development Corporation and helped to finalize plans for a new business incubator with a focus on diversity and inclusion.
- Set up a local community college node and hosts weekly community discussions on race and racism.
- Sits on the board of, "The Welcome Place," a community space that employs a nurse and community outreach specialist to meet the needs of any individual who walks through the door. We offer free meals, programming and a revitalized local Food Shelf and community garden to provide complete food needs for any person in need.
- Meets with developers and assists in plans for a new ecofriendly community center and housing development.
